Hello,

I beg you to not allow ATCO another rider. We cannot afford the extra charges as is, the "extra" on the bill are at least half of the bill. We are very careful on how much power we use and should not have to pay a "customer charge", we don't even have a choice.

Also, I am in the process of developing a farm and currently I have hooked to power. I only have ONE trough heater, nothing else, no lights, no barn, no house, nothing else and my bills are almost the same as my house. If my bill are \$142 a month for one trough heater how am I going to have cattle, pigs and chickens....they will require much more, maybe 10 trough heaters, and at least 2 heat lamps, power for lights in the barn...etc.

Is there a farm rate here like in Alberta? I moved there for a bit and my farm service bill for lights in a barn and a trough heater was \$10-15 a month. I have a farm service here but I pay all the "extras" the same as a residential property. Any profit from farming will go directly to my ATCO bill.

Again, I beg you to consider all the farmers and residential properties that this new rider will damage. I beg you to find a way to make our current ATCO bills affordable!!!
