Good afternoon all parties,

I fully support UCG's position with respect to the essential need to have YEC provide a full cost of service study whether now in this Phase I GRA process or in the Phase II process.

The YUB, all intervenors, the utilities, the government and the public have the right to know what and how great are any and all cross subsidies between all customer classes. Without such information wise decisions simply cannot be taken now or in the future by any party. OIC 2008 / 149 limits the options available to the YUB when it comes to the setting / approval of rates but it does not prevent the Board from Ordering the utilities to cooperatively provide this information.

In the interests of obtaining a cost effective and comprehensible (ie one I and others can get our heads around) GRA review, I would suggest that the YUB consider postponing YEC's current morphed Pahse I & II GRA hearing process until such time as YEC and YECL file a fully combined joint cost of service study and proposed rates document. A YUB Order to this effect would eliminate the possibility of having to hold two costly and time consuming future Phase II hearings and indeed would get the whole process back on track in the future so that GRA filings in the small Yukon jurisdiction are simply single phased.
