**Re: Yukon Energy Corporation ("YEC")  
2008-2009 Phase I General Rate Application ("GRA")  
YEC Responses to Information Requests**

By letter dated March 19, 2009 the Yukon Electrical Company Limited ("Yukon Electrical") filed with the YUB a request that YEC be directed to provide further and complete Responses to a number of specific Information Requests. All of the specific questions identified by Yukon Electrical were not answered in a full and complete manner and the failure to do so was not addressed in the manner required by Section 13 of the Board's Rules of Practice (the "Rules"). Likewise, YEC's continued refusal to provide answers to these questions fail to meet the requirements of subsection 13(2) of the Rules.

In its March 19, 2009 letter, Yukon Electrical provided additional elaboration on what was in fact asked in the initial questions, in order to assist the Board in understanding the issue(s) at hand and, hopefully, clarify the matter for YEC.

Unfortunately, instead of using this additional clarification as a basis for answering the question posed, YEC has taken the stance that Yukon Electrical is now asking new questions, which YEC likewise refused to answer, again without regard to the aforementioned Rules. Yukon Electrical attempted to point out the deficiencies in the Responses provided, but this also has been totally ignored by YEC.

In other portions of its lengthy Response YEC refers to information on the record to other proceedings before the Board or filings with other tribunals (ie. the YESAB). Regardless of what may have been filed elsewhere or in the past, this is YEC's 2008-09 GRA and parties are fully entitled to test all matters raised by YEC's Application in the context of these proceedings. information required to allow such testing should properly form part of this record. YEC has not provided any valid explanation of why this should not be the case.

In a number of cases YEC has refused to provide "business cases" to support items contained in its Application. In the Board's recent Decision regarding Yukon Electrical's 2008-09 GRA (Board Order 2009-2 and attached Reasons for Decision) the Board directed Yukon Electrical to file a business case in its next GRA to support the proposed Carcross Diesel Power Plant (p. 37-38/49). Yukon Electrical expects that the Board will apply consistent standards to both YEC and Yukon Electrical regarding the required justification for capital projects.


YEC's non-responsive stance regarding Yukon Electrical's request for full and complete Responses will also result in inefficiencies in the actual hearing process. Yukon Electrical will have no choice but to pursue these matters via cross-examination, when they could have been addressed in advance through the Information Request process.

Yukon Electrical reiterates its request that YEC be directed to respond to the deficient Information Responses, as detailed in its letter of March 19, 2009.
